
RESOLUTION NO. 16-34

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO ADOPT A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) TO MANAGE, CONSTRUCT AND DELIVER THE OLD DIXIE HIGHWAY COMPLETE STREETS PROJECT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FDOT PROGRAM BULLETIN 15-03 IN COMPLIANCE TO THE POLICY FOR PROJECTS NOT ON A ROADWAY WITHIN THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM WITHIN THE LOCAL AGENCY'S RIGHT-OF-WAY/LOCAL JURISDICTION AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Local Agency Program is the Florida Department of Transportation's primary delivery mechanism for managing and constructing off-system projects prioritized in its Five-Year Adopted Work Program that for efficiency, innovation, cost and/or time savings may optimize project delivery; and

WHEREAS, in 2013, a final conceptual plan was agreed upon for Complete Streets Project improvements on Old Dixie Highway from NE 13th Street to the south end of the bridge over the Middle River in Broward County, Florida that included bike lanes, traffic calming including a traffic circle, landscaping, stormwater improvements and pedestrian lighting and is identified by FDOT as FM No.: 432949-1(Project); and

WHEREAS, said Project has been defined as such an off-system prioritized project within the local right-of-way/jurisdiction of the City of Fort Lauderdale not located on the State Highway System; and

WHEREAS, a resolution to endorse FDOT's delivery of said Project within the local agency's right of way/local jurisdiction is required;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida hereby supports the Florida Department of Transportation to manage, construct and deliver the Old Dixie Highway Complete Streets Project in accordance with FDOT's Program Management Bulletin 15-03.

SECTION 2. The office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
