TITLE: Motion to Approve Purchase of Minutes Secretary Services – Prototype,

Inc. - \$173,550

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a three-year contract with Prototype, Inc. for the purchase of minutes secretary services for items 1 and 3 of the solicitation, in substantially the form attached, for a three-year estimated amount of \$173,550; and authorize the City Manager to approve a one-year renewal option contingent upon appropriation of funds.

Background

The Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid #363-11691 (ITB). Upon the scheduled opening date of January 19, 2016, only one bid was received. Prototype has been deemed the single responsive and responsible bidder for items 1 and 3; item 2 (verbatim minutes) was rejected. Pursuant to the ITB's Section 3.17, the City may award part of a bid.

The City has 19 boards and committees serviced by this contract (Exhibit 3). There are approximately 466 meeting hours annually. In addition to providing minutes, this contractor shall attend meetings, provide assistance in ensuring that meeting public records are accurate and complete, record members attendance, and record motions and votes. The Contractor also provides communications to the City Commission within a seven-day turnaround period.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$30,251 in FY 2016. Future expenditures are contingent upon approval and appropriation of the annual budget.
