TITLE:	Motion to Approve Professional Engineering Services for the Repair of the Northeast 1 st Street Bridge – Lakdas/Yohalem Engineering, Inc. – \$39,373 Task Order

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a Task Order (Exhibit 1) with Lakdas/Yohalem Engineering, Inc. for the condition survey, preparation of repair plans and specifications, and construction management services for the rehabilitation of the Northeast 1st Street Bridge No. 865727 in an amount not to exceed \$39,373.

Background

On August 19, 2014 the City Commission approved CAM 14-0933, retaining Lakdas/Yohalem Engineering, Inc. for Structural Engineering Consulting Services; RFQ No. 946-11366. On October 2, 2014, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) sent a letter to the City of Fort Lauderdale stating that some of the framing members of the bridge have severe deficiencies. In response to the letter, the Public Works Engineering Division desires to retain the engineering services of Lakdas/Yohalem Engineering, Inc. to perform a condition survey, generate repair plans and specifications, and provide construction management services.

City Staff engaged in negotiations with Lakdas/Yohalem Engineering, Inc. under the continuing services agreement and agreed upon professional engineering services in the amount of \$39,373.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$39,373 for consultant services and \$7,105 for estimated in house project management fees, for a total amount of \$46,478.
