TITLE:	Motion to Approve Purchase of Mural Painting at Stormwater Pump Station #2 - William Savarese, Inc \$29,000		

## **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an agreement, in substantially the form attached, for a proprietary purchase in the amount of \$29,000 for public artwork at Stormwater Pump Station #2.

### **Background**

The Public Works Utilities Division operates four stormwater pump stations. One station is located in the heart of the Las Olas Riverfront and pumps stormwater collected in the downtown area. This piece of infrastructure is bare and is an ideal location to display a scene depicting the Fort Lauderdale's tropical atmosphere. This painting would be visible to pedestrians and boaters who pass through this area. The design will complement and blend in with the surrounding environment, improve the look of stormwater infrastructure, and enhance the artistic experience for community events and businesses in the area.

Local Artist William Savarese has performed a project of this kind in the past for the Tarpon River Civic Association on the Ron Cochran Bridge located at the intersection of Southwest 7<sup>th</sup> Street and the Southwest 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue Bridge. Staff has researched mural pricing of similar size and quality and has found Mr. Savarese's quote to be fair and reasonable.

Pursuant to Section 2-189, (c)(1), Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale Florida, the City may purchase proprietary items without public bids. Proprietary items such as works of art for public places are defined in Section 2-173 of the Code of Ordinances.

#### Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$29,000.
