

RESOLUTION NO. 16-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION UNDER PROJECT NUMBER 437866-1-52-01 AT THE INTERSECTION OF SW 4th AVE AND SW 28th STREET FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, SW 4th Avenue south of SR 84 is identified on the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) Strategic Intermodal System as a connector; and

WHEREAS, FDOT identified the intersection of SW 4th Avenue and SW 28th Street as having a need for the conversion of a 4-way stop to a signal controlled intersection; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission made the installation of said signal a condition of the project approval for the Broward Addiction Rehabilitation Center (BARC); and

WHEREAS, funding has been provided by the Florida Department of Transportation to install said traffic signal; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale ("City") and the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") wish to execute a Memorandum of Agreement to maintain specific elements constructed under Project Number 437866-1 to include the installation of a traffic signal, ADA improvements, pedestrian crossings, and necessary storm water adjustments; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Federal Highway Administration regulations issued pursuant thereto, there must be an agreement from the City to maintain the project prior to the project being released for construction bid; and

WHEREAS, the improvements being installed will be included within the Traffic Agreement with Broward County and therefore be maintained by Broward County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the proper City officials are hereby authorized to execute a Memorandum of Agreement for the maintenance of said improvements being installed at the intersection of SW 4th Avenue and SW 28th Street with the Department of Transportation.

SECTION 2. The office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage
