The academic success of children in later years depends heavily upon their kindergarten readiness. The first few years of education and preparedness are the most crucial to establishing a solid foundation from which children can adapt to school systems and learn successfully. During this period, children develop Marie Hansen primary skills that form the foundations of reading, writing, counting, and social interaction. Children entering their first years of regular schooling have to be prepared to interact with other children, control themselves, and cooperate with their peers.

Tom McManus Researchers universally agree that early education is the key to academic success Dominick Miniaci for disadvantaged children. Because of their family environments, many children arrive in elementary school unprepared to compete with their more advantaged peers, lacking in language and social skills, they are behind before they even begin. High quality early education makes it possible for these children to Dulce Stephens compete and succeed from the start. Research shows that children who learned Terry Stiles more in kindergarten, compared to similar students, were less likely to be single parents, went to college in higher numbers, had higher incomes, and had retirement plans.
