TITLE: Motion to Approve Purchase of Elevator Maintenance and Repair Services

- Xpert Elevator Services, Inc. - \$71,460

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a one-year contract, in substantially the form attached, with Xpert Elevator Services, Inc. for the purchase of elevator maintenance and repair services at a cost of \$71,460 annually; and authorize the City Manager to approve four one-year renewal options, contingent upon appropriation of funds.

Background

The Parks and Recreation Department is requesting approval for elevator maintenance and repair services for City-wide facilities. The locations include City Hall, Aquatic Complex, War Memorial Auditorium, Parking Services Building, Police Department Headquarters, Public Works Buildings, and Fire-Rescue Stations. Contract prices include labor and materials, as well as overtime and holiday rates.

The Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 563-11717 and received three bids. The bid submitted by Xpert Elevator Services, Inc. has met all of the specifications of the bid and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder.

Resource Impact

It is estimated that the current fiscal year impact to the City could be in the amount of \$19,768, based upon a four (4) month quantity for each location along with an estimated cost for parts. Future expenditures to complete the one-year contract and contract renewals are contingent upon approval and appropriation of the annual budget.
