A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, DELEGATING TO THE CITY MANAGER THE AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE FY 2015 BETWEEN THE CITY OF MIAMI AND THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE FOR SUB-GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$151,674 PROVIDED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND ACCEPTANCE OF SAID FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (USDHS) has provided financial assistance to the Miami urban area in the amount of \$5,225,000 through the Fiscal Year 2015 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the "urban area" is defined as the City of Miami and the City of Fort Lauderdale (City) collectively; and

WHEREAS, the City has received a sub-grant in the amount of \$151,674 with no required match:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The city manager is delegated the authority to accept a grant from the United States Department of Homeland Security and the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management and execute the required documents between the City of Miami and the City of Fort Lauderdale, specifically a Memorandum of Agreement Urban Area Security Initiative FY 2015 in the amount of \$151,674.
