TITLE: Proposed Classification and Compensation Structure and Benefits options

for the Fort Lauderdale Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the CRA Board of Commissioners approve the proposed Classification and Compensation Structure, Benefits options and revised Organizational chart for the CRA.

Background

On February 16, 2016, the CRA Board approved the revision to the CRA By-Laws (CAM #16-0248).

On March 15, 2016, the Board approved the CRA Budget Appropriation (CAM #16-0359), to allow the CRA to hire staff.

At the April 5, 2016 CRA Board Meeting, the Board approved the revised organizational structure for the Community Redevelopment Agency. With the new organizational structure, a net of six new CRA FTEs was approved to carry out the functions of the CRA.

On May 3, 2016, the Board approved the Classification and Compensation Structure for the net six new CRA FTEs.

Today's CAM is being presented to show the Classification and Compensation Structure of the existing City employee's (as well as the new CRA FTE's). This item is being presented as a result of discussion from the May 3, 2016 Board Meeting.

Attached as Exhibit 1, you will find the Classification and Compensation Structure and Benefits options to support the CRA positions. The Classification and Compensation Structure is consistent with the City. Exhibit 2, is the final revision of the Organizational chart for the CRA.

Resource Impact

There will be no fiscal impact to the general fund.
