TITLE: Motion to Approve Purchase of Medical Grade Oxygen and Nitrous

Oxide— Air Gas USA, LLC - \$17,670

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a one-year contract, in substantially the form attached, for the purchase of medical grade oxygen and nitrous oxide from Airgas USA, LLC (Airgas) at an estimated cost of \$17,670; and authorize the City Manager to approve three, one-year renewal options contingent upon appropriation of funds.

Background

Medical grade oxygen is used during treatment of patients in need of respiratory assistance to elevate oxygen levels in their blood. The use of medical grade oxygen provides for increased perfusion of oxygen throughout the body and has been a standard of care since the inception of emergency medical services.

Nitrous oxide is used to treat and mitigate the pain from long-bone fractures and other associated injuries such as back pain and joint discomfort.

Each of the Fire-Rescue Department's apparatus is equipped with oxygen tanks for patient treatment. The predominant use of these materials is during the transport of patients to the hospital.

On February 12, 2016, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 663-11711, and received two bids. Airgas was the bidder with the lowest, responsive bid and is recommended for award.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$17,670.
