TITLE: Resolution Authorizing Execution by the City Manager of a Letter of

Concurrence for a Setback Waiver for Rahn Bahia Mar, LLC

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve authorizing execution by the City Manager of a letter of concurrence for a setback waiver for Rahn Bahia Mar, LLC.

Background

Per Section 18-21.004(3)(d), Florida Administrative Code, all structures including mooring pilings, breakwaters, jetties and groins, and activities must be set back a minimum of 25 feet inside the applicant's riparian rights lines. Marginal docks, however, must be set back a minimum of 10 feet. An exception to the setback can be made when a letter of concurrence is obtained from the affected adjacent upland riparian owner.

As the adjacent upland riparian property owner, the City of Fort Lauderdale understands that the subject project will be located within the riparian rights area of 801 Seabreeze Boulevard, Fort Lauderdale, and the City does not object to the proposed structure or activity being located within the area required as a setback distance from the common riparian rights lines.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this item.
