Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the execution of a three year agreement, in substantially the form attached, with Coral Springs Regional Institute of Public Safety. This agreement will commence on June 22, 2016 and conclude on June 20, 2019.

Background

EMT and Paramedic students require clinical experience in order to complete their respective program. This practical experience shall be provided during the EMT/Paramedic Ride Along Program.

The City has a similar agreement with Broward College to offer the same experience to their EMT and Paramedic students.
