Tuition Fees – Supervisory Leadership Course - \$32,000

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the utilization of the Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund for tuition fees for a Supervisory Leadership Course in the amount of \$32,000.

Background

The Federal Bureau of Investigation – Law Enforcement Executive Development Association (FBI-LEEDA) offers a Supervisory Leadership Course designed specifically for first-line supervisors and middle managers. The FBI-LEEDA's faculty members are executive law enforcement professionals, and the course goal is to enhance our sergeants' leadership abilities. Attendees will be engaged in personality diagnostics, leadership case studies, mentoring, performance management, risk management and credibility. This course is student-centered and rich in facilitated dialogue and group work. Sixty-four of our police sergeants will participate in the course. The cost of tuition for this course is \$500.00 per sergeant.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$32,000.00 for FY 2016.
