RESOLUTION NO. 16-92

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO ADOPT A RESOLUTION IN FLORIDA DEPARTMENT SUPPORT OF THE TRANSPORTATION POSTING "NO THRU TRUCKS" SIGNAGE AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF EAST OAKLAND PARK BOULEVARD AND MIDDLE RIVER DRIVE, IN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Broward County Traffic Engineering Division ("BCTED") has recommended that a "No Thru Trucks" sign be posted at the southwest corner of the intersection of East Oakland Park Boulevard and Middle River Drive, in the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, in an effort to enhance public safety in that residential area due to neighbor complaints of continuous commercial truck traffic; and

WHEREAS, the southwest corner of the intersection of East Oakland Park Boulevard and Middle River Drive lies within the jurisdiction of the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT); and

WHEREAS, the cost to construct and install a "NO THRU TRUCKS" sign at said intersection will be funded by FDOT; and

WHEREAS, a formal resolution from the City of Fort Lauderdale is required by FDOT in order for the new sign to be installed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida hereby supports the installation of a "No Thru Trucks" sign at the southwest corner of the intersection of East Oakland Park Boulevard and Middle River Drive, in the City of Fort Lauderdale, in order to enhance public safety in that residential area.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
