## Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution providing for a merit salary increase for Cynthia A. Everett, City Attorney, effective July 1, 2016.

## **Background**

The Employment Contract between the City of Fort Lauderdale and the City Attorney dated June 18, 2013, allows for the City Commission to grant merit increases to the City Attorney to the extent that the City may determine that it is desirable to do so on the basis of an annual performance review.

The City Commission considered City Commission Agenda Memo # 16-0774, City Attorney Annual Performance Review and Merit Adjustment, at its Regular Meeting on June 21, 2016. Based on the discussion on June 21, 2016, the City Attorney proposes to the City Commission that the City Attorney receive a merit salary increase commensurate with her review and her responsibilities, effective July 1, 2016
