A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, ENDORSING THE TITLE VI PROGRAM PLAN FOR THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale desires to provide a transit system that offers convenient, accessible, and reliable transportation in advancement of economic vitality, a clean environment, and support of the community that connects riders to destinations and other transit options in Fort Lauderdale; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale receives funding from the Federal Transit Authority (FTA) to accomplish these goals; and

WHEREAS, the FTA has specific guidelines and expectations of their grantees to meet Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987; and

WHEREAS, the FTA requires both recipients and subrecipients to provide a Title VI Program Plan update every three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale submitted the last Title VI Plan Program Update in 2013; and

WHEREAS, an updated City of Fort Lauderdale Title VI Plan Program Update 2016 has been drafted to meet the requirements set forth by FTA Circular 4702.1B;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the recitals set forth above are incorporated in this Resolution.
