A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE BUDGET OF \$115,700 FOR THE SUNRISE KEY NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2016 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2017.

WHEREAS, pursuant to applicable provisions of law, the City Commission has prepared a tentative budget for the Sunrise Key Neighborhood Improvement District for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2016 and ending September 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing has been held as stated above and comments from the public concerning said proposed millage rate and tentative budget have been heard and considered; and

WHEREAS, as set forth during the tentative budget hearing, the appropriations and revenue estimate for the Budget for the Sunrise Key Neighborhood Improvement District fiscal year starting October 1, 2016 and ending September 30, 2017 is in the amount of \$115,700; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale to adopt a tentative budget for the Sunrise Key Neighborhood Improvement District for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2016 and ending September 30, 2017;
