Graphics Installation and Removal – Graphic Designs International, Inc. -
\$133,324

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a three-year contract, in substantially the form attached, for the purchase of the installation and removal of vehicle graphics from Graphic Designs International, Inc. in the estimated amount of \$133,324; and authorize the City Manager to approve two additional one-year renewal options, contingent upon appropriation of funds.

Background

On June 24, 2016, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid 863-11794 for the installation and removal of vehicle graphics. On bid opening day, July 7, 2016, the City received a total of two bids. The bid from Graphic Designs International, Inc. has met all of the specifications of the bid and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bidder.

Resource Impact

There will be no current fiscal year impact. There will be a FY 2017 fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$133,324 in FY 2017, from PBS580101-6416 (Fleet Services). Future expenditures are contingent upon approval and appropriation of the annual budget.
