TITLE: Resolution Adopting the FY 2017 Wave Streetcar Non-Ad Valorem
Assessment and Assessment Roll

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission conduct a public hearing and adopt a resolution approving the Annual Assessment and Assessment Roll for the Wave Streetcar for Fiscal Year 2017, beginning October 1, 2016 and ending September 30, 2017.

Background

The City of Fort Lauderdale imposed the Wave Streetcar Assessment, a non-ad valorem assessment on July 9, 2013, for the purpose of funding the capital costs of constructing transportation improvements within the Wave Streetcar Assessment Area (Resolution 13-131). The Wave Streetcar Project will provide for and result in an increased level of necessary infrastructure services and enhancement of area recreation and utilization; promote user-friendliness; and enhance overall aesthetics of the area.

The City opted to collect the Wave Streetcar Assessment through the use of the uniform method for the levy, collection, and enforcement of non-ad valorem assessment in accordance with Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes (2014).

The computation of Annual Wave Streetcar Assessment, required to be conducted on or before the July 1 preceding each Fiscal Year pursuant to Section 2.04 of Resolution 13-95, has been performed and it has been determined that there will be no change to the adopted Assessment Roll. The FY 2017 Wave Streetcar Assessment proposes to retain the same non-ad valorem rate schedule as last fiscal year equal to \$99 per dwelling unit for residential property; \$.09 per building square feet for non-residential property; and \$0.03 per land square feet for land, which in total will generate approximately \$2,114,000.

Pursuant to Ordinance No. C-13-14 and Resolution 13-131 during the budget adoption process and prior to September 15 of each year, the City Commission shall adopt an

Annual Assessment Resolution for each Fiscal Year in which Assessments will be imposed to approve the Assessment Roll for such Fiscal Year.

Resource Impact

This Non-Ad Valorem Assessment will generate approximately \$2,114,000 in revenue for Fiscal Year 2017.

Strategic Connections
