- TITLE: Conflict of Interest Policy for Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) and Beach Business Improvement District (BID) Advisory Committee Members

Direction from the City Commission is requested on establishing a Conflict of Interest Policy for the Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) and Beach Business Improvement District (BID) Committee Members.

Members of the CRA Advisory Board are subject to regulations set forth in Part III, Chapter 112, Florida Statues which restricts public officers from doing business with their agency and from having an employment or contractual relationship with a person or entity which is subject to the regulation of doing business with their agency. Section 112.313(12), Florida Statutes, provides that the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale as the appointing body of the advisory board upon full disclosure of the transaction, can, by a two-thirds vote, waive certain conflicts of interest.

The Conflict of Interest policy established through this discussion will be used in furtherance of the Beach Business Improvement District (BID) Central Beach CRA Plan, Central City CRA Plan and the Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights (NWPF) CRA Plan.
