**TITLE:** Motion Authorizing the Execution of Revocable License Agreement with  
Broward County for Non-Exclusive Access and Use of County Right-of-  
Way

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**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a motion to authorize the execution of a Revocable License Agreement with Broward County for the non-exclusive access and use of Broward County right-of-way to facilitate construction of certain right-of-way improvements.

**Background**

The Dillard Park Homeowners Association received a Neighborhood Community Investment Program grant for the installation of brick paver crosswalks along Northwest 23 Avenue between Northwest 13 Street and Northwest 11 Street. Northwest 23 Avenue is a Broward County Road.

The Revocable License is attached as Exhibit 1 with the location map.
