**TITLE:** Motion to Approve Contract for the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport  
Runway Incursion Mitigation Project – H.L. Pruitt Corp. - \$484,028

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**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a contract award, in substantially the form attached, with H. L. Pruitt Corp. for the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport Runway Incursion Mitigation Project in the amount of \$484,028.

**Background**

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) developed a comprehensive, multi-year program to identify, prioritize, and implement solutions to mitigate runway incursions. Nine areas were identified by the FAA and airport staff as areas of concern that could potentially lead to unauthorized runway incursions at the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport.

To address the noted incursion concerns, the scope of work on this contract includes, but is not limited to, installation of in-ground light emitting diode (LED) runway guard lights, elevated LED runway guard lights, conduits, directional boring, cabling, concrete work, surface painted symbols, and modifications to an electrical vault.

On April 19, 2016, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 263-11720. Three bids were received on June 7, 2016. The bid submitted by H.L. Pruitt Corp. in the amount of \$484,028, has met all of the requirements of the bid and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder.

The FAA has provided grant funding in the amount of \$435,624 for 90% reimbursement of eligible construction costs for this project. The remaining \$48,404 is available from the project budget.

### **Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$484,028 for the contract award and \$114,350 for estimated consultant and in-house project management fees for a total of \$598,378. This item is contingent upon approval and appropriation of the October 5, 2016 Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM # 16-1088.
