Motion to Approve Purchase of Streetlight Fixtures – Multiple Vendors - \$314,239

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the purchase of streetlight fixtures from multiple vendors for a one-year period in the estimated amount of \$314,239; and authorize the City Manager to approve three one-year renewal options contingent upon approval and appropriation of funds.

Background

The Parks and Recreation Department needs these streetlight fixtures and parts to replace worn out and damaged fixtures as a result of normal wear, weather events and vehicle accidents. These purchases include light bulbs, lighting shields and mast arms for the current high pressure sodium lighting. The City also has the option to purchase light emitting diode (LED) lighting as high pressure sodium lights are gradually discontinued and LEDs become the industry standard. The specific items being purchased from the respective vendors are highlighted in the attached bid tabulation (Exhibit 1).

Procurement Services issued Invitation to Bid No. 362-11789 and received four bids. Awards will be made by line items (as detailed in Exhibit 1) to the lowest bidders that have met all of the specifications of the bid and have been deemed the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidders.

Award will be made to the following vendors:

- Graybar Electric, Medley, FL,
- Torres Electrical Supply, Stuart, FL
- World Electric Supply, Pompano Beach, FL

Resource Impact

There will be a current fiscal impact to the City in the estimated amount of \$314,239. Future expenditures are contingent upon approval and appropriation of funds.
