TITLE: Motion to Approve Contract for Fiveash Water Treatment Plant
Hydrotreaters 3 and 4 Influent Pipe Modifications – RF Environmental
Services, Inc. - \$399,096

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a contract, in substantially the form attached, for Fiveash Water Treatment Plant Hydrotreaters 3 and 4 Influent Pipe Modifications from RF Environmental Services, Inc. in the amount of \$399,096.

Background

The work includes the construction, testing, and placing in service, replacement of piping, valves, fittings and accessories within the influent vaults for Hydrotreaters 3 and 4. The work shall be sequenced so that one of the hydrotreaters will be removed from service and all work shown on the contract documents performed and accepted by the City prior to proceeding with the work on the next hydrotreater.

The Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 263-11809. The City received three bids in response to the solicitation, which were opened on August 26, 2016. The bid submitted by RF Environmental Services, Inc. has met all of the specifications of the solicitation and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bid.

Resource Impact

There will be a current fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$399,096 for the contract award and \$45,000 for in-house project management fees for a total cost of \$444,096.
