TITLE: Motion to Approve Contract for City Hall 1st Floor Security Enhancements

Project – Sun Eagle General Contractors Corporation - \$133,639

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a contract, in substantially the form attached, with Sun Eagle General Contractors Corporation for the City Hall 1st Floor Security Enhancements Project in the amount of \$133,639.

Background

This project is for the remodel and security enhancements of the City of Fort Lauderdale's City Hall first floor lobby. The work to be accomplished under this contract includes, but is not limited to, removing and disposing of the existing security desk, replacement of existing light fixtures, removal of existing furnishings and exposed wire conduits, installation of a new security desk and computer kiosk, installation of new carpeted flooring and decorative wall treatments, and coordination and installation of electrical conduits per the contract design plan sheets and specifications.

On August 6, 2016, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 263-11814. The City received three bids in response to the solicitation which were opened on September 7, 2016. The bid submitted by Sun Eagle General Contractors Corporation has met all of the specifications of the solicitation and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bid.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$133,639 for the contract award.
