- **TITLE**: Resolution Granting a Waiver of Limitations at 357 Idlewyld Drive for the construction of two (2) triple pile clusters, an existing "T" dock, and a modification to the existing "T" dock

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a Resolution granting a Waiver of Limitations for the construction of two (2) triple pile clusters, an existing "T" dock, and a modification to the existing "T" dock.

Background

The applicant is seeking a Resolution granting a Waiver of Limitations (a waiver to allow a dock, mooring structure, or boat lift to extend beyond the maximum distance as defined by City Code) of Sections 47-19.3 (C) and (D) of the Unified Land Development Regulations (ULDR) for the construction of two (2) triple pile clusters, an existing "T" dock, and a modification to the existing "T" dock extending a maximum of +/- 71.4 feet from the property line into the adjacent canal. Although there is not a fee associated with obtaining a Waiver of Limitations, an application fee in the amount of \$300.00 is required. The applicant's narrative specifies that the additional distance for this boatlift is necessary to avoid excessive wave action due to a lack of an adjacent wake zone.

The Marine Advisory Board unanimously recommended approval of the application 13 to 0 (see Exhibit 3). These minutes are in draft form due to the cancellation of the Marine Advisory Board meeting on October 7, 2016.

Resource Impact

There will be a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$300. Revenue related to this action is included in the FY 2017 operating budget in the account listed below.
