TITLE: Motion to Approve Contract for Southwest 9th Street Sanitary Sewer and
Water Main Improvements – Stanford & Sons Trucking Corporation d/b/a
Stanford Construction Company - \$190,213

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a contract, in substantially the form attached, for the Southwest 9th Street Sanitary Sewer and Water Main Improvements Project with Stanford & Sons Trucking Corporation, d/b/a Stanford Construction Company (Stanford), in the amount of \$190,213.

Background

To better serve the properties between Riverside Drive and Interstate 95, the neighbors residing on a private road extension of Southwest 9th Street requested sanitary sewer improvements. The properties in this area are currently either undeveloped or on septic tank services. In 2014, the homeowners dedicated utility easements to the City to allow for the construction and maintenance of public utilities, including a new sewer main with lateral service connections and a new water main and service connections. This project consists of all labor, materials, and equipment required to construct approximately 425 linear feet of water main and 370 linear feet of sewer main and to restore the project site, as indicated in the bid documents.

On August 15, 2016, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid number 163-11810. The bid was opened on September 7, 2016 and five bids were received. The bid submitted by Stanford has met all of the specifications of the solicitation and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bid recommended for award.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$190,213 for the contract and \$19,200 for in-house project management fees for a total cost of \$209,413.
