## Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a motion to authorize execution of an amended Revocable License with Florida Panthers, Inc., in the substantially the form attached, for the construction of a temporary ice rink at Huizenga Plaza.

#### **Background**

In January of 2016, City staff reached out to the Florida Panthers to discuss the possibility of providing ice skating opportunities at Huizenga Park during the holiday season. Through much discussion, this activity is scheduled to take place from November 23, 2016 – January 8, 2017. The Florida Panthers will operate the ice skating rink and will program other activities with its production.

Attached as Exhibit 2, is an estimated expense sheet for expenditures covering Security, Water, Electricity, Sod, Hotel expenses, tents and lights.

Approval of the Revocable License Agreement is subject to review and approval by the City Attorney's Office.

Insurance policies are subject to review and approval of the Risk Manager.
