Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the settlement of the police liability claim in the matter of Dmitry Lyubimov v. City of Fort Lauderdale, et al. Case No. CACE 14-017138 (13) - \$150,000.

Background

The plaintiff, Dmitry Lyubimov, filed a police liability claim and lawsuit against the City, the arresting officer, and two detectives, alleging false arrest, malicious prosecution, and intentional infliction of emotional distress, allegedly arising from an arrest on July 5, 2011.

Through negotiations, a settlement was reached in the amount of \$150,000 subject to the approval of the City Commission.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$150,000.
