#### DESIGN CRITERIA PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AND PACKAGE FOR THE PROPOSED FORT LAUDERDALE AQUATIC CENTER IMPROVEMENTS

#### **PROFESSIONAL SERVICES**

This Task Order is pursuant to the Continuing Service Contract Agreement (No. 246-11374-1) between the City of Fort Lauderdale, a Florida municipality, ("CITY") and Synalovski Romanik Saye, ("CONSULTANT"), a Florida Limited Liability Company, in accordance with the terms of the agreement for professional services dated August 19, 2014 between CITY and CONSULTANT ("MASTER AGREEMENT").

#### PROJECT BACKGROUND

This Task Order is to provide a Design Criteria Package and Professional Services for the proposed Fort Lauderdale Aquatic Center Redevelopment Project located at 501 Seabreeze Boulevard, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33316. The CITY is proposing improvements to the Fort Lauderdale Aquatic Center as described in the scope of work below and will use design-build as the project delivery method. The City will procure a design-build team through a request for proposal (RFP). A Design Criteria Package is needed as part of the design-build RFP document. The CITY has requested for the CONSULTANT to provide a Design Criteria Package and Professional Services for the proposed Aquatic Center improvements described in the scope of work below. The Design Criteria Package will include preliminary drawings, outline specifications, descriptive narrative, cost estimate, and construction schedule. The Professional Services will include assistance during the design-build RFP bidding and evaluation process.

#### SCOPE OF SERVICES AND DELIVERABLES

The Scope of Services to be provided by CONSULTANT shall be as follows:

- Task 1 Kick-Off Meeting A project kick-off meeting will be held with the CITY staff to go over project goals and objectives, project approach, project delivery timeline and project deliverables.
- Task 2 **Programming** CONSULTANT will meet with CITY staff to determine the programmatic requirements for the project. The CITY will communicate to CONSULTANT the needs and wants of the project and the CONSULTANT will assist the CITY in prioritizing these requirements. CONSULTANT will prepare a summary of the requirements from the CITY and generate a final program showing all of the required spaces along with accompanying square footage. This program will be the basis for the preliminary drawings.
- Task 3 **Preliminary Drawings** Preparation of Preliminary Design drawings for the proposed project establishing a visual/graphic representation which will describe the design intent of the project. CONSULTANT will prepare all of the necessary documentation including, but not limited to:
  - a. Overall project site plan and location map showing surrounding buildings, streets, structures, etc.
  - b. Site plan indicating all proposed site and building demolition which will be part of the project scope.
  - c. Rendered site plan, illustrating the Aquatic Center including proposed pools and buildings, landscaping, and relationship to the existing buildings.
  - d. Floor plans to scale, illustrating all functional program elements, showing adjacencies to other spaces and indicating room sizes.

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- Task 4 **Outline Specifications** Preparation of project outline specifications indicating and defining major project components as required for the preparation of the design-build RFP. The specifications will define the following systems and building components:
  - a. Site and Civil features, fixtures and amenities.
  - b. Architectural materials, finishes and building assemblies
  - c. Structural elements

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- d. HVAC air handling equipment and distribution system
- e. Electrical panels, distribution and lighting
- f. Plumbing fixtures and systems
- g. Fire protection systems
- h. Pool related equipment and systems
- i. Landscaping and irrigation systems
- Task 5 Narrative Preparation of a descriptive narrative identifying all project components. This narrative will describe in great detail all of the project components required for the delivery of a complete project by the design-build team to the CITY. This narrative will describe all of the project components including but not limited to: architectural, structural, mechanical, electrical, plumbing, pool equipment, civil, site, landscaping, etc., as listed in the task above.
- Task 6 **Cost Estimate** As part of the Design Criteria Package, the CONSULTANT will also provide an engineer's estimate of probable construction cost. This estimated cost can be used by the CITY as a tool for establishing/obtaining project funding and also evaluating the Design/Build proposals.
- Task 7 Schedule- CONSULTANT will provide the CITY with a probable construction schedule to be included with the RFP documents.
- Task 8 **Bidding** CONSULTANT will assist the CITY as needed during the Bidding process. CONSULTANT will respond as needed to any Requests for Information (RFI's) from the potential bidders regarding technical information on the project. CONSULTANT will also attend the Pre-Bid meeting and assist the City as needed during this meeting.
- Task 9 Evaluation of Design-Build Packages After the bids have been received, CONSULTANT will assist the CITY with the evaluation of the design-build packages for compliance with the established Design Criteria documents. Consultant will evaluate each submitted proposal and prepare a report of our findings indicating areas of compliance and non-compliance, along with a final recommendation if required by the CITY.

#### Scope of Work for Proposed Aquatic Center Redevelopment Project:

- 1. Remove existing 50M Main Competition Pool and provide new expanded fully FINA compliant standard pool with (2) moveable stainless bulkheads.
- Remove existing Diving Pool and underground observation room and provide new fully FINA compliant Diving Pool with dive tower including five (5) platform levels (1M, 3M, 5M, 7.5M, 10M), and 1M and 3M springboard. Provide metal bleacher for +/- 550 spectator capacity on the west side of the Dive Pool.
- 3. Remove existing Spa for divers and provide new covered spa.
- 4. Repair existing 50M training pool with new surfacing and gutters.
- 5. Repair existing Instructional Pool with new surfacing.
- 6. Raise pool deck to allow for increased pool depths needed for competition level-use.
- Remove existing grandstand building and bleachers on north side of facility and provide new grandstand with spectator restrooms, concessions, ticket office, and metal bleachers for +/- 1500 spectator capacity with a fabric shade canopy.
- 8. General site improvements which include
  - a. New sports-lighting for pool and pool deck areas.
  - b. Upgrade to an on-site chlorine generator system
  - c. Resurface the asphalt driveway and parking lot, restripe parking lot, repair broken curb stops, repair irrigation system, refresh landscaping, repair and/or replace pedestrian lights

A detailed list of project assumptions and exclusions is shown on Exhibit A.

#### **Deliverables:**

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Deliverables for this project shall consist of the following:

 CONSULTANT shall provide a PDF copy of the Design Criteria Package including the legal description of the site, survey information concerning the site, interior space requirements, pool specifications, and material quality standards for the project for the CITY's review and a final Design Criteria Professional package will be issued upon its review and issuance of comments.

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#### **PROJECT ASSUMPTIONS**

Specific assumptions for the project:

- 1. Any work beyond the scope of services will require a separate written authorization and will be considered Additional Services.
- 2. Cost estimate report assumes development of construction costs only and does not include development of pre-construction costs.
- 3. A complete list of project assumptions and exclusions is shown on Exhibit A.

#### **CITY'S RESPONSIBILITIES**

The CITY's project manager, or a designated representative, will coordinate this task order for the CITY. CITY to provide CONSULTANT with plans and contract specifications for cost estimating. CITY shall be available for consultation.

#### ADDITIONAL SERVICES

If authorized in writing by the CITY as an amendment to this Task Order, the CONSULTANT shall furnish, or obtain, Additional Services of the types listed in Article 8 of the Agreement. The CITY, as indicated in the Agreement, will pay for these services.

#### PERFORMANCE SCHEDULE

The Consultant shall provide a draft report/estimate as identified in Task 1 within ninety (90) working days after receipt of a notice to proceed (NTP).

#### PROJECT FUNDING

Performance of this project is at the CITY's discretion and may be contingent upon the CITY receiving funding.

#### METHOD OF COMPENSATION

The services performed will be accomplished using the Not-to-Exceed method of compensation. Reimbursable expenses associated with these services are not included in the fees and will be itemized separately, subject to an established Not-to-Exceed limit. The total hourly rates payable by the CITY for each of CONSULTANT's employee categories, reimbursable expenses and sub-consultant fees are shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.


