**TITLE:** Resolution Adopting the Existing Street Name of Seven Isles Drive (NE/SE 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue) between Las Olas Boulevard and Desota Drive

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution to formalize the existing street name of Seven Isles Drive (NE/SE 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue) between Las Olas Boulevard and Desota Drive.

**Background**

The City is seeking to officially adopt the name Seven Isles Drive (NE/SE 23 Avenue) between Las Olas Boulevard and Desota Drive (Exhibit 1). The Seven Isles Homeowners Association supports this action, as was requested in their letter to the City dated October 2016 (Exhibit 2). Seven Isles Drive currently exists as the primary street name and NE/SE 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue as the secondary street name between Las Olas Boulevard and Desota Drive (Exhibit 3).

Seven Isles Drive was never formally adopted by the City as an official street name. By formalizing, the post master can recognize the street name and Broward County, as the maintaining agency of traffic signage, can maintain the signs.
