TITLE: Resolution Authorizing Submittal of a Co-Application, with the City of

Oakland Park for a Continuous Quiet Zone along the South Florida Rail

Corridor in Broward County

#### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing submittal of all necessary documents to the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA), as a coapplicant with the City of Oakland Park, to establish a continuous quiet zone along the South Florida Rail Corridor (SFRC) in Broward County.

## **Background**

SFRC is used by the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA) and Amtrak to operate passenger rail service and by the CSX to operate freight service.

The federal Train Horn Rule (49 CFR Part 222) regulates the sounding of train horns in advance of public grade crossings and provides an opportunity for local governments to establish "quiet zones" within which locomotive engineers will cease the routine sounding of horns when approaching public highway-rail grade crossings. A requirement of this designation is to mitigate the increased risk presented in the absence of horns through the installation of safety measures such as additional crossing gates and small medians to reduce access to the tracks when a train is passing. The required mitigation measures are in place throughout the SFRC corridor within Broward County.

The Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization will assist the cities of Fort Lauderdale and Oakland Park with their co-application to the FRA.

### **Resource Impact**

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
