TITLE: Motion Approving a Revocable License Agreement with Beach Majors
GMBH, LLC for the Construction of a Temporary Beach Statue

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a motion to authorize execution of a Revocable License with Beach Majors GMBH, LLC, in the substantially the form attached, for the construction of a temporary beach statue at Las Olas Boulevard and A1A.

Background

The inaugural SWATCH Beach Volleyball tournament was held on Fort Lauderdale Beach from September 29, 2015 to October 4, 2015. At the November 15, 2016 Commission meeting, a five-year agreement was approved for the return of SWATCH Beach Volleyball, with games from Tuesday, February 7, 2017 – Sunday, February 12, 2017. As part of the organizers efforts to promote the volleyball tournament, event organizers have requested to place a beach statue, attached as Exhibit 1, on A1A and Las Olas Boulevard from Wednesday, January 19, 2017 to Sunday, February 12, 2017. The requested approval does not extend to approval of any signage on the statue.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this item.

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included within the Infrastructure Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:
