TITLE:	Motion Accepting FY16 Department of Justice - Office of Community Oriented Policing Services - COPS Hiring Program Award - \$1,000,000

## **Recommendation**

It is recommended that City Commission approve a motion authorizing the proper City officials to accept a grant from the United States Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS), FY16 COPS Hiring Program and to execute any documents required to accept funds.

#### **Background**

The COPS Hiring Program provides direct funding to law enforcement agencies to hire/rehire career law enforcement officers in an effort to increase their community policing capacity and crime prevention efforts. In June 2016, the City submitted a proposal which sought to implement a community policing strategy that would strengthen local partnerships and enhance our agency's capacity to prevent, solve and control crime. The grant award will cover up to 75% of the approved entry-level salary and fringe benefits of eight newly hired full-time sworn police officers over the three year award period with a minimum 25 percent cash match and maximum federal share of \$125,000 per position.

## Resource Impact

The total project cost is \$1,621,134. There is a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$1,000,000 and a local cash match in the amount of \$621,134. Funds for the cash match are budgeted in the FD-001-9129. The Department of Justice Law Enforcement Trust Fund will be used to perform a one-time purchase of vehicles and law enforcement equipment to outfit the new officers. Additional required cash match will be appropriated as part of the FY18/19 budget process. This item is contingent upon the approval of the Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM #17-0039.
