RESOLUTION NO. 17-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A COMMUNITY AESTHETIC FEATURE AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE STATE ROAD A1A PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE SIGN PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale ("CITY") is desirous of constructing welcome signage along the State Road A1A (SR A1A) Pedestrian Bridge which connects the Bahia Mar Complex to Fort Lauderdale Beach Park; and

WHEREAS, a Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement ("Agreement") is required by the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") for the City to construct the proposed bridge signage within FDOT rights-of-way. This Agreement requires the CITY to fund all costs for the design, construction and maintenance of the project; and

WHEREAS, in January 2016, a competitive procurement process was completed for fabrication, construction, and installation of the sign project and an award in the amount of \$212,936.40 was recommended to Acolite & Claude United Sign Co., Inc. as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, after execution of the Agreement, a permit will be issued and the façade will be finalized and installed within six to eight weeks;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Commission hereby authorizes the proper City officials to execute a Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement with FDOT for the design, construction and maintenance of the proposed bridge sign.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That if any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That the office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.

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<u>SECTION 4</u>. That all resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed;

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
