TITLE: Motion to Approve Chronic Homeless Housing Collaborative Grant

(CHHC) Agreement with Broward County for \$446,929 for FY 2017

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a motion authorizing the City Manager to accept the Chronic Homeless Housing Collaborative Grant (CHHC) agreement with Broward County for \$446,929 for the purpose of providing permanent supportive housing and supportive services for the most vulnerable chronically homeless in Fort Lauderdale.

Background

On August 28, 2012, the City of Fort Lauderdale was accepted to become Broward County's partner in a 2012 Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Continuum of Care Competition. The City submitted an application for a project designed to provide permanent supportive housing for the chronically homeless. As one of 235 United States communities taking part in the 100,000 Homes Campaign, the City of Fort Lauderdale identified the most vulnerable chronically homeless people in our community and successfully placed twenty homeless individuals and two homeless families in permanent supportive housing in 2014.

On March 17, 2015, the Broward County Commission renewed grant funding for the CHHC program and allocated \$446,929 for fiscal year 2016. On December 1, 2015, the City Commission approved amending the FY 2016 operating budget and appropriated the grant funds in the amount of \$446,929, a cash match in the amount of \$47,763, and a \$10,000 cash match from the United Way for a total appropriation of \$504,692. Further on December 15, 2015, the City Commission authorized the City Manager to accept the renewal of the Chronic Homeless Housing Collaborative Grant (CHHC).

On December 21, 2016, the City received a new agreement for the Chronic Homeless Housing Collaborative Grant to ensure continuity of the management of the grant program. The term of the agreement is for one year with the option to renew for up to two (2) additional one year periods. This is a reimbursable HUD grant that will be administered by Broward County as provided in the agreement, in substantially the form

The grant award is divided into four separate units as follows:

Supportive Services	\$ 84,630
Operations	\$ 94,146
Leasing	\$ 253,270
Administration	\$ 14,883
Total	\$ 446,929

(Note: The total amount is after Broward County subtracted their administrative costs in the amount of \$14,883 from the total \$461,812 HUD award.)

The CHHC collaborative partners have agreed to renew their commitment of cash matches and in-kind services as follows:

In addition, the Police Department Outreach Team and the Taskforce Fore Ending Homelessness will continue to assist in identifying the most vulnerable homeless population and the Salvation Army will continue to provide emergency shelter.

The City will also renew the sub-agreements with its CHHC project partners: Broward Partnership for the Homeless, The Salvation Army of Broward County, United Way of Broward County, and the Taskforce Fore Ending Homelessness. Staff will bring these renewed agreements before the City Commission in the near future.

The City's partners on this CHHC project are either non-profits or a governmental agency and pursuant to the City Code of Ordinances Section 2-189(c) may be exempt from the City's competitive process. Staff recommends accepting the Chronic Homeless Housing Collaborative Grant (CHHC) agreement with Broward County for \$446,929 for continuity of providing permanent supportive housing and supportive services for the most vulnerable chronically homeless in Fort Lauderdale for 2017.

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$456,929 from grant resources with a required cash match of \$47,763.
