TITLE: Motion to Approve Change Order No. 6 for South Side School Restoration

Project – DiPompeo Construction Corporation - \$228,186.47

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve Change Order No. 6, in substantially the form attached, in the amount of \$228,186.47 for the South Side School Restoration Project, and add sixty-five (65) calendar days to the contract with DiPompeo Construction Corporation (DiPompeo).

Background

On November 3, 2015, the City Commission awarded a contract for the South Side School Restoration Project to DiPompeo with a total bid of \$3,114,000 including allowances and \$103,000 for additional parking as a bid alternate (CAM #15-0885).

The restoration work includes, but is not limited to, complete interior renovation of the existing school building with some exterior improvements and modifications. The exterior work consists of enclosing the existing southwest facing breezeway and stair tower, new exterior doors, new roofing over the two southwest facing exterior doors, and the addition of a ramp to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act. The site improvements include the construction of two parking lots with 37 parking spaces, along with sidewalks, walkways, lighting, landscaping, irrigation, and utilities work.

Change Order No. 6 is for additional work associated with the information technology (IT) programming changes affecting data, closed circuit television, security, access control, and telecommunications. The additional work consists of constructing a new IT room on the second floor, adding electrical power and circuitry for the new IT room, and door and door hardware changes resulting from the added access control and security components. The height of the ceilings and soffits in certain rooms needed to be lowered to allow access for the added conduit runs associated with the new IT work. Additionally, there are finished flooring changes which were requested by the stakeholder. Some of the ceiling mounted air handler units needed to be changed to comply with fire ratings of the ceilings. The kitchen exhaust fan and ducts conflict with the existing conditions of the building and require revisions. A flagpole has been added which will be placed in the front yard.
