## **RESOLUTION NO. 17-34**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, WAIVING THE PROVISIONS OF DIVISION 2, PURCHASING, OF CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE V OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, REGARDING COMPETITIVE BIDDING, COMPETITIVE QUOTES, AND PURCHASING THRESHOLD AMOUNTS, FOR THE PURCHASE OF ADDITIONAL WATER EXTRACTION AND REMEDIATION OF WATER DAMAGE AND MOLD IMPACT GOODS AND SERVICES FROM DECON ENVIRONMENTAL & ENGINEERING, INC.

WHEREAS, Section 2-171, Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, (the "Code"), excludes the applicability of the Purchasing Division of the Code when waived by the City Commission by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has negotiated additional expenditures for Water Extraction and Remediation of Water Damage and Mold Impact Services, the scope of services; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-171 of the Code excludes from the applicability of the Purchasing Division of the Code "[p]urchases of goods or services for which the provisions of this division are waived by the city commission by resolution"; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the City's best interest to approve an amendment to the agreement with Decon Environmental & Engineering, Inc., as negotiated by the City Manager, and waive provisions of the Purchasing Division of the Code as to the additional services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Commission approves an amendment to the Agreement for Water Extraction and Remediation of Water Damage and Mold Impact Services ("Agreement") between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Decon Environmental & Engineering, Inc. in substantially the form attached to Commission Agenda Memo No. 17-0236.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the provisions of Division 2, Purchasing, of Chapter 2, Article V of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, regarding competitive bidding, competitive quotes, and purchasing threshold amounts, are waived for the purchase of Water Extraction and Remediation of Water Damage and Mold Impact Services from Decon Environmental & Engineering, Inc. made pursuant to the attached Agreement.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
