**TITLE:** Motion Authorizing Design Services for Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport  
West Perimeter Loop Road – HDR Engineering, Inc. – \$50,777 Task  
Order

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**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a design services task order (Exhibit 1) for the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport (FXE) West Perimeter Loop Road with HDR Engineering, Inc. (HDR), in an amount not to exceed \$50,777.

**Background**

The Airport is recommending that a perimeter loop road be constructed on the west side of the airfield to minimize vehicle/equipment crossings at the approach end of Runway 9. Currently, vehicles on the north side of the airport cross Runway 9 in order to relocate equipment to areas south of the runway. These crossings affect Air Traffic Control Tower operations and airfield traffic, increasing the possibility of unauthorized incursions. The construction of the new road will serve to minimize runway crossings and enhance safety of airport operations. A similar road was constructed last year on the east side of the airfield.

Staff has negotiated Task Order No. 16, with HDR Engineering, Inc., the airport's general aviation consultant, to provide design services in the amount not to exceed \$50,777. The task order will consist of conducting Airport staff review meetings, preparing the construction plans and phasing schedule, surveying, geotechnical testing, cost estimating, technical specifications, environmental permitting, and provide assistance during the bidding process.

**Resource Impact**

There is a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$50,777 for the task order and \$22,195 for estimated in-house project management fees for a total estimated cost of \$72,972.
