Brief Project Summary: The Sweeting Park is Located on the North Fork of the New River. The City is in the process of enhancing the park. The enhancement project is a replacement of two wooden docks with construction of a single dock made of sustainable recycled plastic. The two existing docks demolition will be completed under another active construction contract. The new dock will provide access to the river for a scenic vista, fishing, paddle boarding, canoeing and crabbing. Staff applied for this grant last year, but permits were not in hand when due. Permits are now in hand.
