## GRANT PRE-APPLICATION FORM

**Brief Project Summary:** With Grant assistance from the Florida Inland Navigation District and the Broward Boating Improvement Program, the City installed floating docks (540 linear feet) at five downtown locations along the New River. The docks provide access along the Riverwalk for smaller vessels at no charge. They are heavily used by residents and visitors of Ft. Lauderdale. During special events they are fully occupied. The Riverwalk Trust approached the City requesting two additional floating docks to be installed. This purpose of this project is to complete phase I design and permitting efforts to install additional floating docks along the North side of the New River west of the FEC railroad bridge. Staff intends to apply for this grant's required 50% match with the Broward Boating Improvement Program. The combined grants will be used as offsetting matches, which is permitted by each grant program.


The City has received many FIND Waterways Assistance Program Grants over the course of many years.
