TITLE:	Motion to Approve Utilization of Law Enforcement Trust Funds – Smart Board Interactive Panel and Software – Audio Visual Innovations Inc \$21,549.81

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the utilization of Law Enforcement Trust Funds to purchase a Smart Board Interactive Panel with software by Audio Visual Innovations, Inc. in the amount of \$21,549.81.

Background

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department has established a Real Time Crime Center (RTCC) within the Department headquarters. The RTCC has become the centralized location for the real-time monitoring and operational command center to manage and support police responses to particular incidents and events occurring throughout the city. The Smart Board will be installed in the Chief's Conference room and will be configured to be connected to the RTCC for viewing digital content (video, images, etc).

This solution will facilitate senior level briefings, incident monitoring as well as After Action Debrief meetings. In addition, the Smart Board will support everyday meetings by displaying PowerPoint presentations, videos, maps and other electronic documents or applications for the department.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$21,549.81 for FY 17. Funding is contingent upon the approval of Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM 17-0107.
