**TITLE:** Motion to Approve First Amendment to Agreement for Backflow  
Prevention and Plumbing Services - Pipeline Plumbing Services of  
Broward, Inc.

---

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the first amendment to an agreement for backflow prevention and plumbing services to amend the contract period to an initial three (3) years, and authorize the City Manager or designee to approve two (2) one-year renewal options, contingent upon appropriation of funds.

**Background**

The City Commission approved the contract with Pipeline Plumbing Services of Broward, Inc. for the purchase of backflow prevention and plumbing services on November 1, 2016 (CAM #16-1247). The agreement contained scrivener errors in the memorandum recommendation and draft agreement, reflecting the agreement terms which were different from the term included in the bid solicitation.

The first amendment to the agreement (Exhibit 1) reflects the corrected contract period commencing on November 1, 2016 and ending on October 31, 2019, with two (2) one-year renewal options, as advertised in the bid solicitation for these services.

**Resource Impact**

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
