Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager or his designee to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the State of Florida to access Driver and Vehicle Information Database System (DAVID).

Background

The Transportation and Mobility Department's Parking Services Division requires electronic access to the Florida Department of Highway and Safety and Motor Vehicles to obtain vehicle registered owner information, including addresses, for use in the collection of parking citation fines as allowed by Florida State Statutes. The current agreement expired on March 9, 2017. The new MOU shall take effect upon the date of last signature by the Parties and shall remain in effect for six (6) years from this date unless sooner terminated or cancelled.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
