## AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT RELATED TO ANNEXATION OF THE RIVERLAND AREA

	THIS AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT is made this day of2017, by and between BROWARD COUNTY, a political subdivision of		
referre	tate of Florida, acting by and through its Board of County Commissioners, hereinaftered to as "COUNTY," and the City of Fort Lauderdale, a Florida municipal corporation, nafter referred to as "CITY."		
Riverl	WHEREAS, the CITY and COUNTY entered into an agreement for annexation of the and Area into the CITY on December 3 <sup>rd</sup> , 2002 ("Agreement");		
which	WHEREAS, the parties acknowledge that the CITY has met all of its obligations under greement except with regard to the expenditure of \$700,000 (the "Remaining Sum"), has already been paid to the CITY in full by the COUNTY, pursuant to Subsection G on 15 of Exhibit B of the Agreement;		
WHEREAS, the CITY and COUNTY wish to amend the Agreement to allow the CITY the flexibility to allocate the Remaining Sum for land acquisition for public park use;			
	DW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants senterein and other good and valuable consideration, the CITY and the COUNTY agree as so:		
1.	The above-stated recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.		
2.	The CITY represents and acknowledges that the COUNTY has fully met all of its obligations under the Agreement, and nothing stated in this Amendment shall resurrect any COUNTY obligation(s) contained in the Agreement or create any new COUNTY obligation. Any claim(s) that the CITY could otherwise raise under the Agreement is/are hereby waived and released.		
3.	The parties agree that, in addition to other expenditures that are permissible under the Agreement, the CITY may use the Remaining Sum on land acquisition for public park purposes.		
4.	The parties agree that the CITY shall expend the Remaining Sum, on an expenditure permitted by the Agreement as amended hereby, by, 2022. If the Remaining Sum is not expended (on permitted expenditures) in full by the CITY by that deadline, the balance of the Remaining Sum shall be paid by the CITY to the COUNTY within thirty (30) days thereafter.		

- 5. The CITY agrees that, if any or all of the Remaining Sum is expended to acquire land for public park purposes, the acquired property shall be used in full as public park space for the benefit of CITY residents including residents of the annexed area. The obligation to use the acquired land for such public park purposes shall remain in effect through December 31, 2067. The CITY represents and agrees that any such property acquired with any or all of the Remaining Sum will be located within the area that was annexed pursuant to the Agreement.
- 6. Except as expressly modified hereby, all other terms and provisions of the original Agreement between the parties shall remain in full force and effect.
