A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA FOR ELECTRONIC ACCESS TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAY SAFETY AND MOTOR VEHICLES' DRIVER AND VEHICLE INFORMATION DATABASE SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale's Transportation and Mobility Department's Parking Services Division requires electronic access to the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles' Driver and Vehicle Information Database System to obtain information for use in the collection of parking citation fines; and

WHEREAS, the City's current agreement with the State of Florida to access such information expired on March 9, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida requires a requesting agency to execute a Memorandum of Understanding as a prerequisite to receiving electronic access to the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles' Driver and Vehicle Information Database System;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the State of Florida for electronic access to the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles' Driver and Vehicle Information Database System on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
