**TITLE**: Motion to Approve First Amendment to License Agreement for Aerial

Adventure Course - Air Play Adventures, LLC

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a first amendment to license agreement, in substantially the form attached, for an aerial adventure course.

# **Background**

On September 7, 2016, the City Commission approved an agreement for an aerial adventure course at Snyder Park with Air Play Adventures, LLC (Commission Agenda Memo 16-0663). On November 1, 2016, the City Commission approved a revised agreement (Commission Agenda Memo 16-1337). The revision provided for a renewal option to be exercised by the Licensee.

The purpose of this amendment is to incorporate Request for Proposal 565-11551 into the agreement and to include a Payment and Performance Bond which was included in the original solicitation but omitted from the agreement.

#### **Resource Impact**

There is no fiscal impact to the City associated with this item.

## **Strategic Connections**

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included within the Neighborhood Enhancement Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:
