RESOLUTION NO. 17-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A JOINT PARTICIPATION STATE AGREEMENT WITH THE OF **FLORIDA** DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT"), TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING OF \$132,980 OR 5% OF THE COST, WHICHEVER IS LESS, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE TAXIWAY **FOXTROT** PAVEMENT REHABILITATION AT FORT LAUDERDALE EXECUTIVE AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, the pavement milling and re-surfacing of approximately 3,600 linear feet of airfield pavement along the western section of Taxiway Foxtrot and the reconstruction of the intersection at Taxiways Bravo and Foxtrot at the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport ("FXE") will improve airfield operations; and

WHEREAS, new taxiway edge-lights, sodding and pavement striping will be installed as part of the project and existing guidance signs will be relocated based on the new intersection layout; and

WHEREAS, FDOT and the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, wish to enter into a Joint Participation Agreement ("JPA") to accept grant funding in the amount of \$132,980 or 5% of the cost, whichever is less, of this project; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, declares that authorizing the acceptance of such funds and executing said JPA is in the best interest of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Joint Participation Agreement with the State of Florida Department of Transportation, to accept grant funding of \$132,980 or 5% of the cost for construction of the Taxiway Foxtrot Pavement Rehabilitation at the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all necessary documents prior to their execution by the proper City officials.
