TITLE: Resolution Approving an Amendment to the FY 2017 Not for Profit Grant

Participation Agreement with Riverwalk Fort Lauderdale, Inc. - \$31,250

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution approving a First Amendment to City of Fort Lauderdale FY 2017 Not for Profit Grant Participation Agreement between City of Fort Lauderdale and Riverwalk Fort Lauderdale, Inc., ("First Amendment"), in substantially the form attached, and authorizing the City Manager to execute the First Amendment on behalf of the City.

Background

Within the FY 2017 Budget, the City Commission approved contributions to not-for-profit organizations that serve a public purpose by supporting the needs of the community while making a positive impact.

The City Commission approved a Grant Participation Agreement with Riverwalk Fort Lauderdale, Inc., on October 5th, 2016, in the amount of \$150,000. The amendment to the agreement will increase the grant amount by \$31,250 for a total of \$181,250. Additional funding is being recommended in order for Riverwalk Fort Lauderdale, Inc. to stage or cause to be staged various events in the Riverwalk area that are intended to enhance the attractiveness of the Riverwalk as an entertainment destination.
