Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission amend Resolution No. 17-46, which established the Infrastructure Task Force (Task Force), authorizing a designated board member from the Planning and Zoning Board and a designated board member of the Budget Advisory Board to serve on the Task Force in lieu of the respective board Chairperson should that Chairperson be unable to serve.

Background

At the March 7, 2017 Regular Meeting, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 17-46 establishing the Infrastructure Task Force. Section 3, Membership, of the resolution provides for the Chairperson of the Planning and Zoning Board and the Chairperson of the Budget Advisory Board to serve as members of the Infrastructure Task Force. It is proposed to amend Resolution No. 17-46 to allow a board member designated by each respective board to serve on the Task Force should the Chairperson be unable to serve.
